THE UNIVERSITIES ACT, No. 16 OF 1978

ORDINANCE made by the University Grants Commission under Section 140 read with Section 18 of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978.

Ordinance

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Postgraduate Institute of Medicine (Amendment) Ordinance and shall come into force on 01st March, 1993.

2. The Postgraduate Institute of Medicine Ordinance No. 01 of 1980, published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 83/7 of April 10, 1980, as last amended by the Postgraduate Institute of Medicine (Amendment) Ordinance No. 02 of 1990, and published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 642/9 of December 27, 1990, is hereby further amended as follows :—

(1) In paragraph 10 thereof :—

(a) by the repeal of clause (h) of sub-paragraph (1) of that paragraph and the substitution therefor of the following clause :—

“(h) the immediate past Director of the Institute ;”

(b) by the repeal of clauses (j), (k), (l), (m) and (n) of subparagraph (1) of that paragraph and the substitution therefor, of the following clauses :—

“(j) Deans of all Faculties of Medicine of the Universities, established under the Act ;

(k) Deans of all Faculties of Dental Science of the Universities established under the Act ;”

(c) by the repeal of sub-paragraph (2) of that paragraph and the substitution therefor, of the following subparagraph :—

“(2) (a) One member from each of the Faculties of Medicine of the Universities, established under the Act, elected by the Faculty Board of each such Faculty from among the Heads of Departments of each such Faculty ;

(b) One member from each of the Faculties of Dental Science of the Universities established under the Act, elected by the Faculty Board of each such Faculty, from among the Heads of Departments of each such Faculty ;

(c) Eight members appointed by the Commission from among the persons who have rendered distinguished service in educational, professional, scientific or administrative spheres ; provided that at least five members so appointed shall be from among the members of the medical profession ;”

(2) In paragraph 14 thereof :—

(a) by the repeal of clauses (d), (e), (f) and (g) of subparagraph (1) of that paragraph and the substitution therefor, of the following clauses :—

“(d) One member from each of the Faculties of Medicine of the Universities, established under the Act, elected by the Faculty Board of each such Faculty, from among the Professors, Associate Professors and Senior Lecturers of each such Faculty ;

(e) One member from each of the Faculties of Dental Science of the Universities, established under the Act, elected by the Faculty Board of each such Faculty, from among the Professors, Associate Professors and Senior Lecturers of each such Faculty ; ”

(b) by the repeal of clauses (c), (d), (e) and (f) of subparagraph (2) of that paragraph and the substitution therefor, of the following clauses :-

“ (c) One member from each of the Faculties of Medicine of the Universities, established under the Act, elected by the Faculty Board of each such Faculty, from among the Professors, Associate Professors and Senior Lecturers of each such Faculty ;

(d) One member from each of the Faculties of Dental Science of the Universities, established under the Act, elected by the Faculty Board of each such Faculty, from among the Professors, Associate Professors and Senior Lecturers of each such Faculty ; ”

(3) In paragraph 25 thereof by the substitution for the definition of “ Speciality in Medicine ” of the following new definition :-

“ Speciality in Medicine ” means Anaesthesiology, community Medicine Family Medicine and General Practice Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Ophthalmology, Pathology, Paediatrics, Psychiatry, Radiology, Surgery, Forensic Medicine, Microbiology, Otolaryngology, Radiotherapy, Oncology, Dental Surgery and Health Science or any other speciality approved by the Commission upon the recommendation of the Institute and the University. ”.
