## APPLICATIONS TO SIT FOR THE APTITUDE TESTS TO FOLLOW FOUR YEAR SPECIAL DEGREE PROGRAM IN TRANSLATION STUDIES

Applications are invited for the above aptitude tests which is to be held on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 at the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, from the candidates who possess the minimum requirements for university admission as specified under section 3.2 & 8.16 of the Hand Book on "Admission to Undergraduate Courses of the Universities in Sri Lanka for Academic Year 2014/2015 " issued by the University Grants Commission.

Applicants, who submitted applications to the University Grants Commission to be considered for admission to the above Degree program conducted by the Department of Languages, Faculty of Social Sciences and Languages, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, are required to apply to sit and pass the aptitude test mentioned herein, if they wish to be considered for admission to the respective course.

2. **B.A.** (Special) Degree in Translation Studies (Department of Languages, Faculty of Social Sciences and Languages)

The Department of Languages, Faculty of Social Sciences and Languages, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka introduces the study program which offers candidates the opportunity of graduating with the BA (Special) Degree in Translation Studies. This is a four year professional degree introduced as part of the overall strategic initiative to cater to the national needs of Sri Lanka.

Throughout the program tri-lingual policy will be implemented to provide students with competency in Sinhala, Tamil and English giving special attention to develop their language skills in the mother tongue. The degree program is designed to fulfil the increasing demand for pragmatic translation skills.

## 3. Submission of Applications

Applicants are required to prepare their own application forms on A4 Size paper in the format given in the university web site <u>www.sab.ac.lk</u>.

Each application should accompany a paying in voucher obtained from the Bank of Ceylon for Rs. 500/- drawn in favour of the Vice-Chancellor, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, Account No. 0002246976, being the fee for the aptitude test (**Cheques & Postal / Money Orders will not be accepted**) along with copy of (A/L) certificate as applicable and a certificate indicating the result of the common general paper, **certified by the Head of the School or a Justice of the Peace**. The official stamp of the certifying officer should be placed on each certified copy. (**Original Certificates should not be sent.**) Candidates are required to send a self-addressed envelope 10  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 22  $\frac{1}{2}$  cm in size without stamps along with the application which will be used to post the admission card for the Aptitude Test.

Duly completed application along with the certificates should be sent under the Registered Post, to reach the Assistant Registrar, Student Affairs, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, P.O. Box 02, Belihuloya **on or before 05<sup>th</sup> June 2015.** Mention, "BA (Special) Degree in Translation Studies" on the top left hand corner of the envelope. Any incomplete applications will be rejected.
