- (3) Where two or more examiners are jointly responsible for setting and moderating, the rate shall be divided proportionately among them.
- (4) The paper for a practical examination shall be deemed to be one paper in respect of a group of five or lesser number of candidates in a given medium.
- (5) Responsibility of Typing, Translating etc. lies with the person setting papers.

### Basis of calculating the rates of payment for practical examinations

## 1. First and qualifying examinations

A group is defined to have less than or equal to 20 candidates in a given medium, irrespective of the number of hours for a group.

- 04. Lab Attendant (2 for 10 candidate or less)
