FEES AND TRAVELLING OF VISITING STAFF

Your kind attention is drawn to the Commission Circular Nos. 837 of 29.12.2003, 07/2013 of 24.04.2013, Establishments Circular Letter Nos. 07/2012 of 16.04.2012, 07/2013 of 14.05.2013, letter Nos. UGC/HR/6/1/13(I) dated 10.02.2014 and UGC/IUA/2/PGS/6 dated 03.06.2009.

2. University Grants Commission at its 888th meeting decided to revise the rates of payments for visiting staff of the university system as given below.

- * The Governing Authority of the University/Institution can decide the maximum amount to be paid for Visiting Lecturers of postgraduate programmes subject to a minimum of Rs. 1000/- per hour and inform the UGC accordingly. These payments should be made out of the funds generated through such postgraduate courses.
- 3. Travelling will be paid in addition to the above rates in terms of the existing Government rates.

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- 4. Further, the Commission at its 908th meeting held on 18.12.2014 decided to pay not less than US\$ 50 per hour upto a ceiling of US\$ 100 per hour for foreign experts in specialized fields, with a view to obtain their services through Teleconferencing and Skype, if required on specialized subjects.
- 5. The Higher Educational Institutions/Institutes are advised to satisfy the following conditions as laid down by the Treasury in making visiting appointments;
 - a) Under no circumstances Visiting Lecturers be appointed when the facility is available within the Higher Educational Institution/Institute concerned. Appointment should be strictly on a need basis.
 - b) All Higher Educational Institutions/Institutes should ensure that the available resources are fully utilized before obtaining the service of Visiting Lecturers to conduct lectures for both undergraduate and postgraduate courses by fixing norms for each and every lecturer of the Higher Educational institution/Institute.
 - c) No requests for additional allocation of funds in this regard will be entertained.
- 6. Commission Circular Nos. 837 of 29.12.2003 & 07/2013 of 24.04.2013, Establishments Circular Letter Nos. 07/2012 of 16.04.2012 & 07/2013 of 17.05.2013, Letter Nos. UGC/IUA/2/PGS/6 dated 03.06.2009 and UGC/HR/6/1/13(I) dated 10.02.2014 are hereby rescinded.
