In the Aptitude Test the applicant would be tested on knowledge in Cinema and Television, as well as General Knowledge and Creativity.

The applicants who have applied to the UGC on the above conditions would be called for an Aptitude Test. Those who display a high standard of competency would be selected.

#### 01. Aptitude test

This test anticipates assessing the general knowledge and creative skills in the field of Film and Television. **Exam will be conducted in sinhala medium.** 

#### 02. Oral test

The successful applicants from the aptitude test will assess the awareness in the field of Film and Television.

Registered Post should send completed applications in the following structure to the Deputy Registrar/Examinations, University of Kelaniya, Dalugama, Kelaniya on or before  $06^{\text{th}}$  July 2020. On the top left hand corner of the envelope one should state "BA (Special) Degree in Film and Television Studies".

The following documents should be submitted along with the application.

- A receipt of Rupees 1,000/= paid to A/c Number 055-1001-30667553, of the People's Bank, Kelaniya Branch. The receipt could be obtained from any branch of the People's Bank.
- II. A Principal or a Justice of Peace with his official seal should certify the results of G.C.E. (A/L)-2019, Z-Score and G.C.E. (O/L) examinations.
- III. If there is a difference in the names in the certificates with the name in application, an Affidavit should be provide certifying both names are of the same person.

The Aptitude Test date will be inform later. Incomplete and unclear applications would be rejected.
