Information on the educational opportunities in the Republic of Uzbekistan
In the areas of Physical Education and Sports

Please note that the Embassy of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the Russian Federation has informed, that according to the Order of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Uzbek State University for Physical Education and Sports of the Republic of Uzbekistan has opened a joint Faculty of the Belarus State University for Physical Education.

Further, according to the Order of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, there was created a branch Unit of the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education Russian State University for Physical Education, Sports, Youth and Tourism in the city of Samarkand.

It may be noted that the Information received from the Republic of Uzbekistan on the above mentioned two educational institutes respectively in Belarus and in Russia along with the information on Uzbek State University for Physical Education and Sports of the Republic of Uzbekistan are attached herewith.

Information on the Faculty of the Belarus State University for Physical Education

BSUPE – Belarus University for Physical Education is the main profile institution for higher education in the Republic of Belarus and it trains specialists in the field of physical education, sports and tourism.

In 2019/2020 academic year the Belarus State University for Physical Education and Sports and the Uzbek State University for Physical Education and Sports (USUPES) opened a joint Faculty on Mass Health and Fitness, Sports Work and Tourism physically based at the latter University.

Citizens of different countries of the world can study on the Faculty, including the citizens of the countries-participants of the CIS, in case they have the necessary education level.

The Faculty is intended to satisfy the demand of the citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan and other countries in higher education, the demand of the society and the State of the Republic of Uzbekistan in personality formation, preparation of qualified staff.

The education at the Faculty will be performed in Russian according to the joint educational programmes.

The main targets of the faculty are:

Organization in the sphere of physical education, sports and health in bachelor's, master's degree and education;

Additional training and advanced training of teachers of different categories, coaches, referees and physical training and sports managers to develop physical education and sports;

Performing employer-sponsored master's and PhD education in the sphere of physical education and sports as well as holding joint scientific research;

Development of the system of training of the highly skilled specialists and academic personnel basing on the principle of continuity and succession of production and science, as well as balanced integration into the international academic community;

Development and strengthening of long-term relations with the leading educational institutions and research centers in the field of physical education and sports, their development and strengthening.

Educational process on the Faculty is provided by higher-education teaching personnel of BSUPE and USUPES.

The graduates of the Faculty will receive a dual degree of the Uzbek State University for Physical Education and Sports (Double Diploma).

Admission to the intramural studies is done through the representatives of the Belarus State University for Physical Education by sitting exams.

On 15 July 2019 the admission board for the bachelor's and master's joint programme of the Uzbek State University for Physical Education and Sports and the Belarus University for Physical Education started its work and it carries out:

PROGRAMME FOR BACHELOR'S PREPARATION OF STAFF:

1. Education through programme 1+3

Speciality: "Sports and pedagogical activity" (coaching activity according to the kind of sports)

Qualification: Coach (of a kind of sports). Physical education teacher.

Kinds of sports: Gymnastics, hockey, figure skating, speed skating.

Place and terms of study: 3 years in the Republic of Belarus (I, İll, IV years), 1 year in the Republic of Uzbekistan (Il year)

Format and cost of education: full-time - 2000 USD per year/4 years.

2. Education through programme 2+2

Speciality: "Sports and pedagogical activity" (coaching activity according to the kind of sports)

Qualification: Coach (of a kind of sports). Physical education teacher.

Kinds of sports: Gymnastics, hockey, figure skating, speed skating.

Place and terms of study: 3 years in the Republic of Belarus (I, III, IV years), 1 year in the Republic of Uzbekistan (II year)

Format and cost of education: full-time - 2000 USD per year/4 years.

• Sports exams in physical education and sports (on a chosen kind of sports)

Upon graduation, the student receives two diplomas of state format of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Republic of Belarus.

Upon graduation, the student receives two diplomas of state format of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Republic of Belarus.

The additional expenses for the citizens of Uzbekistan upon arrival for education to the Republic of Belarus:

- Accommodation in the dormitory of the university: 25-30 USD per month
- Medical examination (primary/annual): 100 USD
- Registration in the department for citizenship and migration: approximately 60 USD per year.

The list of documents to be provided to the admission board:

- 1. Passport/copy of passport
- 2. a) bachelor's degree: original school graduation certificate, original education diploma, mentioning the list of subjects studied and the marks for them (grades)
 - b) master's degree: original education diploma with attachment (bachelor level)
- 3. Application for the name of the Rector
- 4. Free from HIV infection certificate issued by an official body of healthcare of a county
- 5. Military service registration certificate or military registration card
- 6. Photo 3.5 * 4.5 (8 copies)

All the before mentioned documents should be translated into Russian and notarized.

In case a student successfully passes the exams, an agreement for education is signed with him and the student receives admission to the degree program.

As soon as the Unit receives the license from the Federal Education and Science Supervision Agency of the Russian Federation the students studying in the Uzbek State University for Physical Education and Sports will be directly transferred to the Unit and continue their education in the Unit.
