## Authorization of Expenditure for the period of March - May 2020

In terms of the article 150(3) of the constitution of Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, HE the President has granted the authority to incurring expenditure from the Consolidated Fund for the period of March to May 2020.

Accordingly, the Secretary to the Treasury issued the Budget Circular No. 01/2020 dated 10<sup>th</sup> March 2020 and informed on allocation of funds under the Head No. 214 - University Grants Commission.

The approved Recurrent & Capital allocation for the period from March – May 2020 is given in Annexure I.

Universities/HEIs are requested to manage the Recurrent & Capital expenditure on priority basis within the authorized expenditure ceilings. New procurement activities should not be commenced during the period of March – May 2020 and priority should be given to settle the outstanding bills of the committed works, goods and services.
