Information on the Safety and Welfare of University Students During Adverse Weather Conditions

The University Grants Commission (UGC) informs the general public, parents, and guardians that all students residing in state universities and affiliated campuses are currently safe and under the close supervision of university officials despite the ongoing adverse weather conditions across several regions of the country.

Each university has designated responsible officers who are in continuous contact with student groups to ensure their safety and provide necessary support. All institutions have taken measures to supply essential requirements, including food, medical care, and other facilities, to the students who remain in hostels.

However, due to power interruptions and weak mobile network signals in several areas, students may have difficulty contacting their families. The UGC kindly requests parents and guardians not to be unduly alarmed in such situations.
