REVISION OF ANNUAL INCOME CEILING FOR PAYMENT OF BURSARIES

Your attention is invited to Commission Circular No. 900 dated 18th November, 2008 on the above subject.

The University Grants Commission at its 800th meeting held on 20th March, 2010, decided to revise age limit of the school going brothers and sisters of Bursary applicants for the purpose of determining their eligibility for Bursaries. Accordingly, the paragraph 3.4 (a) of the above circular is revised as follows.

"3.4 (a) Rs. 24,000/- concession per annum per school going sister/brother who is 19 years or under, up to a maximum of three children".

This revised scheme will come into operation with effect from academic year 2009/2010.

The other provisions in Commission Circular No. 900 will remain unchanged.

Please take action accordingly.
