THE UNIVERSITIES ACT; No. 16 OF 1978

ORDINANCE made by the University Grants Commission under Section 18 read with Section 35 of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978.

Ordinance

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deputy Vice-Chancellor's Ordinance, No. 4 of 1995 and shall come into force upon its publication in the Gazette.
- 2. Subject to the provisions of Section 35 of the Act, a Deputy Vice-Chancellor of a University shall be appointed by the Council of the University (hereinafter referred to as the "Council") from among two names submitted by the University for the consideration by the Commission from the permanent Senior Professors, Professors, Associate Professors and Senior Lecturers, (Grade 1) of the University.
 - 3. No person shall be appointed as the Deputy Vice-Chancellor of University for more than two consecutive terms.
- 4. The Deputy Vice-Chancellor shall be a full-time officer of the University and unless he vacates office earlier or is removed from office under paragraph 5 shall hold office for a period of three years reckoned from the date of his appointment or until he completes his sixty-fifth year, whichever event occurs earlier.
 - 5. The Deputy Vice-Chancellor may be removed from office for good cause by the Council in consultation with the Commission.
 - 6. The Deputy Vice-Chancellor may resign his office by letter addressed to the Vice-Chancellor of the University.
- 7. The Deputy Vice-Chancellor when ceases to hold office or is removed from office shall, unless he has completed his sixty-fifth year, revert to his substantive post he held by him prior to his appointment as Deputy Vice-Chancellor.
- 8. If the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, by reason of illness, absence from Sri Lanka or other cause is temporarily unable to perform the duties of his office, the Council shall, upon the occurrence of such inability, make such arrangements as it may think fit for carrying on the duties of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor. Until such arrangements are made, the Vice-Chancellor or his nominee shall carry on the routine duties of such office.
- 9. If any vacancy occurs in the office of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, the Council shall, upon the occurrence of such vacancy, make such arrangements as it may think fit for carrying on the duties of the office of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, until permanent appointment is made under paragraph 2. Until such arrangements are made, the Vice-Chancellor or his nominee shall carry on the routine duties of such office.
- 10. Subject to the provisions of the Act, the powers duties and functions of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor shall relate to the affairs of the students of the University.
- 11. "The procedure for the appointment of Deputy Vice-Chancellor's Ordinance, No. 1 of 1984", published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 320/6 of 25th October, 1984, is hereby repealed.
 - 12. In this Ordinance -

"Act" means the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978;

"Commission" means the University Grants Commission established under the Act; and

"University" means a University established under the Act.
