Announcement for the students who were unable to apply for the university admission for the academic year 2020/ 2021 on or before the closing date (18th June 2021) for submitting applications.

The submission of applications for the university admission for the academic year 2020/ 2021 based on the results of the G.C.E. (Advanced Level) Examination held in October 2020 was closed on 18th June 2021. However, in case if there are students who could not apply online for university admission due to the travel restriction/ curfew imposed in the country at that time with the spread of Covid-19 pandemic, the University Grants Commission has decided to provide a grace period **from 26th July 2021 to 30th July 2021** for such students to submit their applications.

Please also note that the applicants applying for the university admission during the said grace period will be able to change the order of the “Uni-Codes” online for once **within a period of two (02) weeks from 31st July 2021 to 14th August 2021** by logging into their UGC account.

Important:

The candidates who wish to apply for the university admission during the said grace period should affix their signature correctly on the printed application obtained after submitting the application online and it is mandatory to send a scanned copy or a clear image (photograph) of the fully signed application to the email ID apply2020@ugc.ac.lk. We also ask the students to send the complete application to the University Grants Commission via registered post **on or before 31st July 2021**.
